The Warehouse in Pine River provides a unique facility for meetings, celebrations, parties and so much more, but its After-School program for students in 5th – 12th is what particularly won the vote of the annual Commitment to Community award review team at Crow Wing Power.

Students can go to the Warehouse Monday – Friday from 3:00 – 6:00 p.m. during the Pine River-Backus school year. Students can have a snack, use the electronic gaming room to play Wii, Xbox, Play Station, make crafts, play board games, use the gym, play foosball, air hockey, ping pong, and more all at no charge. They also have opportunities to take field trips like going to a Twins game. There's a required free student membership form signed by a parent or guardian which provides emergency information.

It is closed when school is not in session, but outings and field trips are offered during the summer break. Swimming lessons are also offered during the summer.

The building is owned, operated by, and a ministry of Riverview Church in Pine River. They opened on January 6, 2003 as a service to the community. The air conditioned facility contains a full kitchen, electronic gaming room, meeting room, and a gym. The facility has been used for meetings conducted by the State, county, and city, private businesses, non-profits, various organizations and individual community members. There is no rental fee but

manager, "We strive to provide a safe, enriching environment for youth to come where they are able to develop healthy relationships with other youth and helpful adults. We genuinely care about these students and want to equip them in ways that will help them have hope for their future and to succeed."

Every day after school, kids

come flooding through the doors after being picked up from the school in a van provided by Riverview Church. Serving close to 350 students altogether, there is rarely a dull moment. The majority of students that come on a regular basis are between the ages of 10 and 15, before they have a driver's license or a job. Students love eating the buffet of great snacks provided each day

as well as just hanging out and talking with each other or with one of the staff or volunteers.

Many of the students who go to The Warehouse are struggling with their current life circumstances. Part of the vision of the After-School program is to help students see that they have value as individuals and can break the self-defeating cycles of poverty, chemical abuse, and domestic violence and can aspire for more in life. By teaching life skills through interaction and workshops, like cooking class, the result is that youth are empowered to reach out and successfully take advantage of the opportunities provided for them in our community.



One of the largest outreach events The Warehouse holds is the Block Party, held every year near the end of July. This is a fun event held for all of the community. It is like an indoor/outdoor carnival with games that can be played for prizes. With live music and a meal of hot dogs, chips, and cookies, it is a great time to be had by all. This summer the Block Party will be held on Wednesday, July 22, 2020.

The greatest need The Warehouse has from the community is support in prayer, encouragement, and financial donations, according to Susan. A significant portion of the operating budget each year is provided through community gifts. The Warehouse feels strongly that by working together to champion the needs of the youth in our community and fighting to make a difference, lives can be changed.



A WORD FROM YOUR CEO

A Look Back at the Decade >>>

As we move into a new decade, I thought it might be interesting to review some of the dramatic changes affecting our society during the past ten years.

At Crow Wing Power, advanced technology upgrades, social media, and online tools have greatly enhanced our ability to service members' needs.

The electric utility industry appears to be responding to climate change, increasing renewable energy sources and reducing dependence on fossil fuels. I think perhaps the biggest change we will see is when storage batteries allow us to store renewable energy in great quantities in order to more fully embrace it.

The year 2010 was a banner year for solar installations in the U.S. By the end of 2010, the United States had enough solar to power 500,000 homes. Today, there's enough solar built in the country for 13.5 million homes.

Crow Wing Power installed two smaller community solar arrays, one in 2017 and the second in 2018 so members could purchase renewable energy without the burden of having to erect it at their homes. We now have 41 members purchasing shares of solar power, enough to power eleven average-use homes. It doesn't seem like a lot, but it was embraced by those members desiring solar, despite increased electric costs initially.

A favorable move the Board of Directors made in 2009, allowed us to purchase power from a second wholesale power supplier. Now we have two suppliers, Great River Energy and Basin Electric. That has saved us millions of dollars this past decade.

Nine years ago, we adopted an online tool, called MyMeter that enabled Cooperative members the ability to view and manage their daily and monthly energy use. We upgraded that system to SmartHub in 2014. We currently have 18,900 members using SmartHub to manage their accounts and 7,900 of those members have paperless accounts and use online exclusively.

Currently we have 1,100 members receiving the newsletter electronically as well – which has a very positive impact on our budget.

In 2019, we began to upgrade all of our metering system, a move that prepares us for the future. Our existing metering system was installed in the mid-1990s and had reached its end of life. The technological advances of this new meter system will greatly enhance our ability to serve members quickly and efficiently and benefit members with real-time readings, information and outage control –saving time and manpower.

Societal Changes

Remember the Jetsons? That television show aired in 1962 and portrayed life 100 years from then, (supposedly 2062). We've got 42 years to go, but we have a lot in common with George and Judy today. I'm not sure when Skype or the like became common, but we can now video chat like the Jetsons.

Elroy's classmate was once seen watching the Flintstones on his watch. The Apple watch came out in 2015. I'm not sure if there are any Rosie housekeepers yet, but we do have robot vacuums and lawn mowers. I even saw a robot window cleaner and pet care robots.

Everything is Googled (including much of this article) Google has been around since 1998 and has since gradually taken over the lead in search engines. Everything you need to know is a click away. In many cases you don't even need your phone anymore — Alexa, Siri, or Cortana will instantaneously provide you with the information you need, including telling you when your next Crow Wing Power bill is due.

Some of the following data came from the PEW Research Center or by Googling, but remember there's now a lot of Fake News out there, so don't hold me accountable.

Text messages outrank phone calls as the main means of communication for people under 50.

In 2013 35% of American's owned a smartphone. By early 2019, that number changed to 81%.

In 2005, 5% of the population was using Facebook for social media, but by early 2019, 72% were connected. During this decade, Facebook became a very important communication tool for us. Storm and outage related posts are followed closely at times by over 3,000 of our members.

Privacy is scarce – retailers know what to advertise to you, where you live and your lifestyle preferences.

Cell phone cameras have replaced portable cameras. Your home's thermostat, security


Best Ever Ham Casserole
