Position Purpose

Responsible for the operation and maintenance of the Cooperative's building and grounds for optimal efficiency, employee comfort and safety, positive public image and compliance with applicable laws and Cooperative policy.

Responsibilities

Facilities Management (All buildings and property owned by the Cooperative)

- Assist with maintenance for the Cooperative's buildings, HVAC, mechanical and electrical systems and assigned maintenance equipment.
- Inspection of buildings, grounds, and HVAC system and make any necessary adjustments.
- Responsible for maintaining a clean, safe, and comfortable workplace and the operation of heating and cooling equipment.
- Collects and disposes of waste.
- Wash company vehicles.
- Oversee after hours contracted cleaning team to ensure security and proper cleaning of building.
- Compliance with federal and state laws ordinances and codes pertaining to building and grounds.
- Repair and/or replacement of defective equipment or components.
- Assist with oversight of service contracts with outside vendors and any work performed by outside services.
- Snow removal ensure accessibility to CWP building and grounds.
- Responsible for lawn care/irrigation systems.
- Operation, programming, keying and maintenance of all lock and security camera systems of all CWP's buildings.
- Assist with employees' questions, concerns, including office furniture adjustments.
- Will be back up to getting Crow Wing Power's daily mail pick-up and delivered.
- Fill in and perform duties of Facilities Technician II as needed.
- Other duties as assigned.
